About the grants: We have \$9000 available for these grants. While there is not a limit on the size of the grants, we hope to help as many of our churches or campus ministries as possible. **Any size FRP church or campus ministry may apply.**

The grants may be used for equipment that will enhance the church's social media presence, and in particular, "virtual" worship services, meetings, and events. The grant might also be used to pay personnel for consultations, installation fees, or ongoing services. One possibility you may want to consider: John Fong has worked with several FRP churches on social media and has been very effective. He is willing to work with any FRP church for one year for \$500. However, you may choose to work with anyone you prefer if you feel the need for assistance.

Churches or campus ministries applying for grants are strongly encouraged to have representatives attend a zoom class on creating effective virtual worship that will be taught by Rev. Ralph Hawkins, pastor at Northminster, on **Saturday, January 16 from 10 am to 12 noon**. Whatever your current expertise or experience may be, rudimentary or fairly advanced; you will likely come away with some fresh perspectives.

4. What is the total cost of the project? Does the church or campus ministry have funds that can be used to cover the cost of the project not covered by the grant? If we are unable to fund the entirety of your grant application request, what are your priorities?
5. Who will install the equipment?
6. Who will operate the equipment on an ongoing basis?
7. Please explain why you require a grant to help you with this purchase, and why your church or campus ministry will benefit.
8. Feel free to add any additional rationales that will help us to determine which churches and/or campus ministries will be rewarded grants.
