[Tour Mission San Luis](#), a Spanish Franciscan mission built in 1656 in an effort to bring Christianity to the Apalachee and Timucuan natives. (Depending on the time of year, attend a workshop or take an archaeological site tour.) Afterward, a stopover at the Museum of FL History and later, tour of an architectural treasure - The Goodwood.

Flannery O'Connor was an American novelist, short story writer, and essayist. Best known for her short story, "A Good Man is Hard to Find", O'Connor is widely regarded as one of the best writers of Southern Gothic literature. We'll tour her family farm, Andalusia, and meet the peacocks! This trip includes a trolley tour that features architectural gems of Milledgeville.
