3. To develop programs, personal relationships and fellowship opportunities to encourage growth of the youth program.
4. To help direct year round programs that encourage opportunities for participation in a variety of activities, included but not limited to: camps, retreats, trips, Presbytery activities, mission trips, etc.
5. To encourage our youth to be active participants in worship services, leadership and other church activities.
6. To regularly connect with youth and their families through a wide variety of communication tools (email, Facebook, text messages, fliers)
7. To plan, facilitate and recruit volunteers for the Middle and High school groups for Wednesday and Sunday evening activities.
8. To participate in continuing education as budget and time permits.
9. To serve as a resource person for the annual vacation Bible school as needed and coordinate summer activities for the Youth.
10. To develop, submit and manage a budget, with the assistance of the appropriate ministries for the youth program.
11. To meet with Christian Education ministry and the Session as needed and annually provide a report to include written goals and objectives.
12. To participate in worship leadership as requested and when time permits.
13. To work with the pastor in areas where any of the above may be furthered and advanced.
