## Flint River Presbytery Boundaries Training Policy

In partnership with the Stated Clerk, the Committee on Ministry shall require Sexual Misconduct Prevention Training, Child Sexual Abuse Prevention Training, Harassment, Antiracism, and Self-Care Training for all Inquirers, Candidates, Ministers of Word and Sacrament (Teaching Elders), Commissioned Pastors (Commissioned Ruling Elders), Trained Ruling Elders, Christian Educators, Campus Ministers and Youth Directors every thirty-six months.

This training may be done in person or by electronic means, and the Committee on Ministry shall oversee the records of such training and ensure that those for whom this training is required have participated.

For those coming into the presbytery, a certificate of completion of boundaries training from another presbytery may be accepted if it includes all of the above. For those whose employment requires such training, a certificate of completion of boundaries training may be accepted if it includes all of the above.
